Repair and replacement with new gear under the direction of the Management Committee. Organises stock and distribution of uniforms as required. Submit regular reports to the club Lifesaving Committee. Undertake any agreed task assigned by the President or the Management Committee. Undertake any agreed task assigned by the Club Captain or the Lifesaving Committee. Be prepared to attend as far as possible, all Lifesaving Committee meetings of the Club. Prepare an annual report. |
